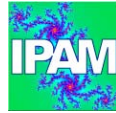


Modern Math Workshop

The eight mathematics institutes and NIMBioS will offer three concurrent sessions preceding the SACNAS annual meeting – one for graduate students and recent PhDs, and two for undergraduates.
